## Format and allocation of points

#### 1. Written examination (850 points)

- General paper (250 points) in English or French
  - Drafting skills (150 points)
  - International affairs questions (100 points)

Will be reviewed and rated by a specialized external consultancy

- Specialized paper (600 points) in any of the official UN languages
  - Essays
  - Short questions

Will be reviewed and rated by the relevant Specialized Board of Examiners

# Format and allocation of points

#### 2. Competency-based interview (150 points)

Will be conducted by the relevant Specialized Board of Examiners

#### Administration

- 3 essays (120 points each): 360 points
- 6 out of 9 short questions (40 points each:
  240 points

#### Humanitarian assistance

- 2 out of 3 essays with 1 mandatory at 170 points, the other at 160 points: 330 points
- 7 out of 9 short questions with 3 (out of 4) at 30 points each and 4 (out of 5) at 45 points each: 270 points

- 2 essays, 1 each from 2 sets, each set containing 2 topics at 180 points each: 360 points
- 8 questions at 30 points each: 240 points
