"After the End of the World" Displaced Persons and Displaced Persons Camp

On display from **26 January to 3 February 2022** in the **VIC Rotunda** (Accessible for VIC badge holders only)

The exhibition focuses on the responses in the immediate period following the war and on Jewish displaced persons, survivors of the Holocaust. The fragments from the past illuminate the work of the administrators of the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA), and chart how, in the aftermath of catastrophic loss, Holocaust survivors navigated their new lives in displaced persons camps. The exhibition is sourced with artefacts and documents from the United Nations Archives and the YIVO Institute for Jewish Research Archives.
